The recycling pick-up will not begin until after September 1st.

Yard Waste – Effective January 1, 2011 our trash company can no longer accept yard waste of any kind that is put out with your regular trash. Our trash hauler M-T Trash has a program for residential yard waste removal. It is an agreement between the individual resident and/or homeowner and M-T Trash. Call M-T Trash for further details.
