Recycling – Universal recycling (by order of the State of Delaware) will begin in September. It is mandatory for municipalities to participate but residents are not required to participate. The Town will be purchasing containers for you to put your recycling in should you choose to. The recycling will be picked up by M-T Trash, our normal trash hauler. The recycling pick-up will not begin until after September 1st.

Yard Waste – Effective January 1, 2011 our trash company can no longer accept yard waste of any kind that is put out with your regular trash. Our trash hauler M-T Trash has a program for residential yard waste removal. It is an agreement between the individual resident and/or homeowner and M-T Trash. Call M-T Trash for further details. Big Saturday – The Big Saturday festivities will be held on Saturday September 3, 2011. Fire Hydrant Testing – Fire hydrant flushing and inspections will take place July 13th and July 14th between the hours of 4:00 am – 7:00 am. When fire hydrants are being flushed, the water may become cloudy or discolored. Cloudy water is caused by air trapped in the water during the flushing process and is harmless. The air bubbles can be removed by running cold water for a few minutes. Discolored water can be cleared the same way, however it may take a little longer for discolored water to become clear.
