**Cash Payments** – Cash payments for taxes, water, and sewer and/or trash bills **MUST** be made in Greenwood Town Hall. Please do not place cash payments in our outside drop box. Money orders and check payments may be placed in the outside drop box for payments to the Town.

**Trash Pick-up** – Waste Management will be providing trash containers to each of our residents free of charge. We are attempting to schedule a date and time for delivery of the trash carts. We will let you know when the trash carts will be delivered.

**Water Meters – Reminder** – The water meters and water meter pits are property of the Town of Greenwood. It is a violation of our Water Ordinance to tamper with the water meter or the water meter pit. Tampering even includes removing the meter pit lid to record your own flows. Please do not tamper with our property.

**Sump Pump Drainage** – If your residence has a sump pump please be aware of where it drains. Your sump pump should not drain into the Town's sewer line, it should drain into a storm drain.

**Yard Waste – Reminder** – Our trash company can no longer accept yard waste of any kind. With Spring coming please do not include leaves, limbs, etc in your weekly trash pick-up. Waste Management will contract with individual residents concerning yard waste. Their phone number is 800-773-7145. You will need to set up a yard waste account for this service. You can also turn this service on and off at your convenience.

**Water Conservation Tips** – In an effort to help the residents of Greenwood conserve water we will be including a monthly water conservation tip. The tip for March – “Next time you add or replace a flower or shrub, choose a low water use plant for year-round landscape color and save up to 550 gallons of water a year.”
