Fire Hydrant Testing – Fire hydrant flushing and inspections will take place July 11th and July 12th between the hours of 4:00 am – 7:00 am. When fire hydrants are being flushed, the water may become cloudy or discolored. Cloudy water is caused by air trapped in the water during the flushing process and is harmless. The air bubbles can be removed by running cold water for a few minutes. Discolored water can be cleared the same way, however it may take a little longer for discolored water to become clear. Grass Ordinance – The Town of Greenwood has a grass ordinance. Anything in excess of 8 inches in height will cause you to receive a notice about cutting your grass. Then if it is not cut within the required time the Town will cut it and bill you for the cost.

Water Conservation Tips – In an effort to help the residents of Greenwood conserve water we will be including a monthly water conservation tip. The tip for July –“To conserve water adjust your sprinklers so only your lawn is watered and not the house, sidewalk or the street.”
