- Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to burn or cause to have burned or permit to have burned leaves, brush, limbs, or any other combustible matter within the corporate limits of The Town of Greenwood without obtaining a special permit for such burning from the Town Council or its designated representative; provided however, that nothing contained herein shall prohibit the use of outdoor fireplaces, grills or other devices for the preparation of food.
