AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING U-TURNS ON
MARKET STREET WITHIN THE TOWN OF
GREENWOOD PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR
THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING
ANY INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of Greenwood in the manner
following, to wit:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to make a U-
Turn with a motor vehicle, carriage, wagon, or other vehicle, on Market Street
within the Town of Greenwood.

Section 2. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance
shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be
fined Ten Dollars (\$10.00) in addition to the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. For the purpose of this Ordinance, a U-Turn shall
mean the turning of a motor vehicle, carriage, wagon or any other vehicle
within the width of the street in such a manner that the said motor vehicle,
carriage, wagon or any other vehicle, after the turn will proceed in the
direction opposite which the said motor vehicle, wagon, carriage or other
vehicle was proceeding prior to the turn.

Section 4. Any Ordinance inconsistent with the provisions hereof
shall be and the same is hereby repealed.
