**Temporary Signs** – Keep in mind the definition according to our Zoning Ordinance is: “A temporary sign is a sign displayed on private property for fewer than 30 days, usually made of non-permanent material such as canvas, cardboard, paper, or wood”.

**Business License** – Per the Town of Greenwood Ordinance C-11 “An Ordinance Respecting the Issuing of Business Licenses within the Town of Greenwood.” All companies conducting business within the Corporate limits of Greenwood are required to obtain a Town of Greenwood business license. This Ordinance was enacted to protect all Greenwood residents. It is the property owner’s responsibility to make sure their contractor has obtained their business license.
