Greenwood Town Elections – The Municipal Elections for the Town of Greenwood were held on Saturday January 17th from 1:00 pm to 7:00 pm. The two winners were Donald Donovan and Dan Nelson. The Town would like to thank everyone who voted.

Cash Payments – Cash payments for taxes, water, sewer and/or trash bills **MUST** be made in Greenwood Town Hall. Please do not place cash payments in our outside drop box. Money Orders and check payments may be placed in the outside drop box for payments to the Town.

Delinquent Properties – Ordinances E-2-E and E-3-A state “Payment for all utility bills is due in full by the end of the month in which the bill is mailed. You also have a ten (10) day grace period. If the bill is not paid by that date the water will be turned off. **NO MORE EXTENSION**”

Snow Removal – Residents of the Town of Greenwood are responsible for the snow removal from the sidewalks in front of their property. This also means tenants who are renting places that have sidewalks. Please remove the snow within 24 hours after the snow stops.

Water Conservation Tips – In an effort to help the residents of Greenwood conserve water we will be including a monthly water conservation tip. The tip for January – “Some refrigerators, air conditioners and ice-makers are cooled with wasted flows of water. Consider upgrading with air-cooled appliances for significant water savings.”
