Consumer Confidence Report – The Town of Greenwood’s annual drinking water report can be viewed on the Town’s website, greenwood.delaware.gov/files/2014/09/2014-ccr1.pdf.

Fire Hydrant Flushing – Fire Hydrant flushing and inspections will take place July 10th and 11th, yes Friday and Saturday morning, between the hours of 4:00 am and 7:00 am. When the hydrants are being flushed, the water may become cloudy or discolored. Run cold water for a few minutes and the cloudiness and discoloration will be cleared. Please try to refrain from washing white clothes during this time. Should you have any questions please feel free to contact Town Hall M-F 8:00 am – 5:00 pm at (302-349-4534).

Delinquent Properties – Ordinances E-2-E and E-3-A state “Payment for all utility bills is due in full by the end of the month in which the bill is mailed. You also have a ten (10) day grace period. If the bill is not paid by that date the water will be turned off. **NO MORE EXTENSIONS**”

Grass Ordinance – The Town of Greenwood has a Grass Ordinance. Anything in excess of 8 inches in height will cause you to receive a notice about cutting your grass. This notice will be mailed only once a year. Then if the grass is not cut within the required time the Town will cut it and bill you for the cost.

Yard Waste – Yard waste may be taken to either Ellendale 302-422-8632 or Bridgeville (Wednesday and Saturday only) 302-337-3521. Please call them for specifics.

Water Conservation Tips – In an effort to help the residents of Greenwood conserve water we will be including a monthly water conservation tip. The tip for July – “Rather than following a set watering schedule, check for soil moisture two to three inches below the surface before watering.”
