Safe Trade Station – The Greenwood Police Department is now a Safe Trade Station. The Police Department has 24-hour surveillance along with officers coming in and out of the area. Residents may use the Town Hall/Police Department lobby during business hours or the parking lot after hours to perform transaction/pick-up from online sales, such as Craigslist. Safe Trade is a program that aims to provide residents additional security when performing online transaction.

Cash Payments – Cash payments for taxes, water, sewer and/or trash bills **MUST** be made in Greenwood Town Hall. Please do not place cash payments in our outside drop box. Money Orders and check payments may be placed in the outside drop box for payments to the Town.

Delinquent Properties – Ordinances E-2-E and E-3-A state “Payment for all utility bills is due in full by the end of the month in which the bill is mailed. You also have a ten (10) day grace period. If the bill is not paid by that date the water will be turned off. **NO MORE EXTENSION**”

Snow Removal – Residents of the Town of Greenwood are responsible for the snow removal from the sidewalks in front of their property. This also means tenants who are renting places that have sidewalks. Please remove the snow within 24 hours after the snow stops.

Water Conservation Tips – In an effort to help the residents of Greenwood conserve water we will be including a monthly water conservation tip. The tip for February – “Know where your master water shut-off valve is located. This could save water as well as prevent damage to your home.”
