Contact Form – The Town of Greenwood would like to make sure our records are as up to date as possible, please fill out the contact form, included in this mailing and return back to Town Hall or the Police Department.

Bulk Trash Pick-Up – The Town of Greenwood will have our bulk trash pick-up on Saturday May 21, 2016. A flyer is included in this month's mailing explaining what you can and what you can't put out for pick-up.

Grass Ordinance – The Town of Greenwood Has a Grass Ordinance. Anything in excess of **8** inches in height will cause you to receive a notice about cutting your grass. This notice will be mailed only once a year. Then if the grass is not cut within the required time the Town will cut it and bill you for the cost.

Cash Payments – Cash payments for taxes, water, sewer and/or trash bills **MUST** be made in Greenwood Town Hall. Please do not place cash payments in our outside drop box. Money Orders and check payments may be placed in the outside drop box for payments to the Town.

Delinquent Properties – Ordinances E-2-E and E-3-A state “Payment for all utility bills is due in full by the end of the month in which the bill is mailed. You also have a ten (10) day grace period. If the bill is not paid by that date the water will be turned off. **NO MORE EXTENSION**”

Yard Waste – Yard waste may be taken to either Ellendale (302) 422-8632 or Bridgeville (Wednesday and Saturday only) (302) 337-3521. Please call them for specifics.

Water Conservation Tips – In an effort to help the residents of Greenwood conserve water we will be including a monthly water conservation tip. The tip for May – “Set a kitchen timer when watering your lawn or garden to remind you when to stop. A running hose can discharge up to 10 gallons a minute.”
