Delinquent Accounts – Property Taxes, Water/Sewer/Trash Bills and other charges due to the Town of Greenwood in a timely manner. Please see to it that you pay your bills so the Town does not have to take other actions.

Yard Waste – Effective March 29, 2012 Waste Management will no longer provide yard waste service, due to lack of interest by Town residents. Yard waste may be taken to either Ellendale 302-422-8632 or Bridgeville (Wednesday and Saturday only) 302-337-3521. Please call them for specifics.

Debris into the Sewer Line – Please refrain from flushing debris down your toilet. Things such as diapers, mop heads etc. can cause damage to our equipment here in Greenwood. Recently damages occurred due to material being flushed into someone's toilet. These damages cost the Town in excess of \$5000 and could cause overtime, our sewer rate to be increased.

Sump Pump Drainage – If your residence has a sump pump please be aware of where it drains. Your sump pump should not drain into the Town's sewer line, it should drain into a storm drain. Discharge of sump pump drainage into the Town of Greenwood's sewer system is a violation of Ordinance E-2-E, Section 5.5.

Snow Removal – Remember, that the residents are responsible for snow removal from the sidewalks in front of their property.

Water Conservation Tips – In an effort to help the residents of Greenwood conserve water we will be including a monthly water conservation tip. The tip for February – “Use a water efficient showerhead. They're inexpensive, easy to install, and can save you up to 750 gallons of water a month .”
