High Volume User Form – Do not forget to turn in your High Volume User form, if you haven't already. This form is to be filled out for any of the reasons listed on the form. You will be charged for the water used, but you will receive a credit on your sewer charges, based on the average sewer charge that you have had in the past. Please return the completed form at your earliest convenience.

Big Saturday – The Big Saturday festivities will be held on Saturday September 7, 2013. Please see the Town's website for a vendor form. The Town's website is greenwood.delaware.gov.

Grass Ordinance – The Town of Greenwood has a Grass Ordinance. As summer comes closer please keep in mind to cut your grass when necessary. Anything in excess of 8 inches in height will cause you to receive a notice about cutting your grass. Then if it is not cut within the required time the Town will cut it and bill you for the cost.

Cut Grass in the Street – It is a violation per Ordinance **A3B** for any owner or tenant to permit grass clippings to be blown, swept or raked into the streets of the Town of Greenwood. This action is detrimental to the public health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Town of Greenwood and if done will be considered a public nuisance. Failure to comply will result in the Town correcting the problem at your expense plus a \$250.00 administrative fee.

Debris into the Sewer Line – Please refrain from flushing debris down your toilet. Things such as diapers, mop heads etc. can cause damage to our equipment here in Greenwood.

Water Conservation Tips – In an effort to help the residents of Greenwood conserve water we will be including a monthly water conservation tip. The tip for May – “Check the root zone of your lawn or garden for moisture before watering using a spade or trowel. If it is still moist two inches under the soil surface, you still have enough water, and don't need to irrigate.”
