Delinquent Properties – Ordinances E-2-E and E-3-A state *“Payment for all utility bills is due in full by the end of the month in which the bill is mailed.* You also have a ten (10) day grace period. If the bill is not paid by that date the water will be turned off. **NO MORE EXTENSIONS**

The tip for November– *“Put food coloring in your toilet tank. If it seeps into the toilet bowl without flushing, you have a leak. Fixing it can save you up to 1,000 gallons per month.”*
