

Ordinance A-17

**“AN ORDINANCE RESPECTING THE NAMING
OF STREETS AND THE ASSIGNMENT OF CIVIC
ADDRESS NUMBERS WITHIN THE TOWN
OF GREENWOOD, AND COMPELLING PROPERTY OWNERS
TO DISPLAY SUCH NUMBERS ON BUILDINGS
SO AS TO BE VISIBLE FROM THE STREET”**

WHEREAS, under Sections 29 (a) (2) of the charter of the Town of Greenwood, the Council is specifically authorized to enact ordinances relating to the health, peace, safety, cleanliness, ornament, good order and public welfare within the community for its residents and is further empowered to impose and enforce the payment of fines and penalties for the violation of such ordinances or resolutions;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Greenwood, in a regularly called and constituted meeting, that from the date of passage of this ordinance, this ordinance shall take full force and effect to wit:

Section 1 – Streets

All new streets within the boundaries of the Town of Greenwood shall be named only by a motion of the Town Council during a duly called and constituted meeting.

Section 2 – Civic Address Numbers

- a) The Town Manager, in order to facilitate the identification of buildings within the Town for emergency services and other purposes, may assign street numbers to all buildings as he deems necessary for the orderly and sequential numbering of buildings on any street.
- b) The Town Clerk will keep and updated map of all assigned street numbers.
- c) The owner of any building assigned a street number, will place such number upon the building so as it is clearly visible from the street.
- d) Such numbering will be no less than a minimum size of 4” high and maximum size of 9” high with a maximum width of 3”.

Section 3 – Penalty

The owner of any building who does not place such number upon the building after being given 7 days notice by the Town of Greenwood of the assignment of a civic address number, shall be guilty of an offence under this ordinance and subject to a fine of \$25 plus costs. Each additional week (seven day period) for which the owner of any building fails to comply with this requirement shall be considered a separate offence.
