AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DISORDERLY CONDUCT
IN OR UPON ANY PUBLIC PLACE WITHIN THE
LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD AND
PRESCRIBING A PENALTY THEREFOR, AND
REPEALING ANY INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of Greenwood in the manner
following, to wit:

Section 1. Whoever shall be disorderly upon the streets or in
any public place within the limits of the Town of Greenwood shall be guilty
of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not less
than Five Dollars ^{25.00} (~~\$5.00~~) and not to exceed ^{100.00} (~~\$25.00~~).

Section 2. For the purposes of this Ordinance, unless the
context indicates otherwise, the following definitions shall be applicable:

(a) "Disorderly" shall mean conduct against or in violation
of the peace, good order, morals, decency or safety of the public, whether
committed by words or acts.

(b) "Public place" shall mean any place which is open to
the general public and upon use of which by the general public there is no
limitation except that required in the interest of safety and good order.

Section 3. Any Ordinance inconsistent with the provisions
hereof shall be and the same is hereby repealed.
