**Delinquent Properties** – Ordinances E-2-E and E-3-A state “Payment for all utility bills is due in full by the end of the month in which the bill is mailed. You also have a ten (10) day grace period. If the bill is not paid by that date the water will be turned off. **NO MORE EXTENSIONS**”

**Temporary Signs** – Keep in mind the definition according to our Zoning Ordinance is: “A temporary sign is a sign displayed on private property for fewer than 30 days, usually made of non-permanent material such as canvas, cardboard, paper, or wood”.

**Business License** – Per the Town of Greenwood Ordinance C-11 “An Ordinance Respecting the Issuing of Business Licenses within the Town of Greenwood.” All companies conducting business within the Corporate limits of Greenwood are required to obtain a Town of Greenwood business license. This Ordinance was enacted to protect all Greenwood residents. It is the property owner’s responsibility to make sure their contactor has obtained their business license.

**Dog Owners** – When you are walking your pets please clean up after them. Animal waste can cause disease and contaminate the water supply.

**Yard Waste** – Yard waste may be taken to either Ellendale 302-422-8632 or Bridgeville (Wednesday and Saturday only) 302-337-3521. Please call them for specifics.

**Water Conservation Tips** – In an effort to help the residents of Greenwood conserve water we will be including a monthly water conservation tip. The tip for October – “Don’t use the toilet as an ashtray or wastebasket. Every time you flush a cigarette butt, facial tissue or other small bit of trash, five to seven gallons of water is wasted.”
