Underage Drinking Awareness Program – On April 23rd 2015, from 5:30 – 6:30 pm there will be a program at the Greenwood Public Library, sponsored by the Greenwood Police Department for individual's age 12 – 20 years old to talk about the dangers of underage drinking.

Delinquent Properties – Ordinances E-2-E and E-3-A state "Payment for all utility bills is due in full by the end of the month in which the bill is mailed. You also have a ten (10) day grace period. If the bill is not paid by that date the water will be turned off. **NO MORE EXTENSIONS**
