Delinquent Properties – Ordinances E-2-E and E-3-A state “Payment for all utility bills is due in full by the end of the month in which the bill is mailed. You also have a ten (10) day grace period. If the bill is not paid by that date the water will be turned off. **NO MORE EXTENSIONS**”

Business License – Per the Town of Greenwood Ordinance C-11 “An Ordinance Respecting the Issuing of Business Licenses within the Town of Greenwood.” All companies conducting business within the Corporate limits of Greenwood are required to obtain a Town of Greenwood business license. This Ordinance was enacted to protect all Greenwood residents. It is the property owners responsibility to make sure their contactor has obtained their business license.

Dog Owners – When you are walking your pets please clean up after them. Animal waste can cause disease and contaminate the water supply.
