


Our offices will be closed July 4th in observance of the holiday.



Ordinance A-5 Reminder: A-5, Section 2 – “It shall be unlawful for any person to burn or cause to have burned or permit to have burned leaves, brush, limbs, or any other combustible matter within the corporate limits of The Town of Greenwood without obtaining a special permit for such burning from the Town Council or its designated representative; provided however, that nothing contained herein shall prohibit the use of outdoor fireplaces, grills or other devices for the preparation of food.”

Trash and Recycle – Trash and Recycling will NO LONGER be picked up in town alleys. Please place trash and recycle bins on the street in front your home.

Greenwood Comprehensive Plan – Greenwood's Comprehensive Plan is open for review and up-dating this year. Our Planning & Zoning Commission will be holding public hearings to obtain comments and suggestions from town residents. These public hearings are held the 2nd Wednesday of every month at 7 pm.

Water Conservation Tip

Maximize the use of natural vegetation and establish smaller lawns. For portions of your lot where a lawn and landscaping are desired, ask your local nursery for tips about plants and grasses with low water demand (such as creeping fescue). Consider planting more trees, shrubs, ground covers, and less grass.

Shrubs and ground covers provide greenery for much of the year and usually demand less water. Use native plants in flower beds. Native plants have adapted to rainfall conditions. Cluster plants that require extra care together to minimize time and save water.
