**Ordinance E-3a Amendment:** E-3a, Section 9.1 – “Nonpayment – If an invoice for water services or any other charge related to the Greenwood water system (i.e. water assessments, fines and interest, repairs to meters damaged by customers, etc.) is more than fifteen (15) days past due, the Town may, in addition to any other remedies available, disconnect the water service. At least ten (10) days prior to disconnecting the water service, a disconnection notice shall be posted on the property and mailed or hand delivered to the property owner. If the property owner’s mailing address on file with the Town is not the same address as the property, notice shall also be mailed or hand delivered to the occupant. The disconnection notice shall indicate the total outstanding balance that must be paid to avoid disconnection of the water service and that the property owner or occupant may file a written appeal with the town manager within ten (10) days of the date of the notice. All proceedings to disconnect water service shall be stayed during an appeal.” *EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1<sup>st</sup>*
