**Ordinance D-17 Amendment:** D-17, Section 1. – “Church Street between Market Street and Minor Street is hereby designated for two-way traffic.”  
**SYNOPSIS:** “This ordinance repeals the prior Ordinance D-17 and establishes Church St. as a two-way street between Market St. and Minor St. This ordinance creates parking restrictions on Market St. and Church St. and requires the placement of a stop sign on the west side of Church St. approaching Minor St. This ordinance affirms the two-hour parking restriction on the north side of Market St. between the railroad tracks and Church St. Lastly, this ordinance establishes a minimum fine of \$20.00 and a maximum fine of \$30.00 for violations of this ordinance, along with a voluntary payment procedure.”

**Beaver Street:** Beaver Street has been repaved as per State Representative Dave Wilson and State Senator Gary Simpson have provided funds from State Community Transportation Fund.

**Annual Town Election:** As of December 14, 2018, the filing deadline to file as a Candidate for the January 19, 2019, Greenwood Town Council Election, two (2) people have filed their candidacy.

Donald Donovan and Michael Moran, both currently serve on the Greenwood Town Council, filed to be candidates for the election.

Due the fact that two (2) seats are open for election this year and two (2) incumbent members of the Town Council are the only properly filed candidates, Greenwood will not conduct an election in 2019. The two (2) incumbents are automatically re-elected.

### Winter Driving

### Driving Restrictions Explained:

Level One: Drivers are discouraged from operating a motor vehicle on the state's roadways, unless there is a significant safety, health or business reason to do so.

Level Two: Travel on the roads is restricted to emergency workers, public utilities, healthcare providers including hospital staff, private sector food and fuel deliveries, and those industries, companies or organization that have been provided a waiver, including businesses with pressing continuity and operational issues.

Level Three: Complete ban on driving except for first responders and utility personnel.
