Ordinance A-3, Section 4 Reminder – “It shall be unlawful for the owner of any property or the tenant of an owner to permit or maintain the growth of any grass more than eight (8) inches in height anywhere in the Town of Greenwood and the growth of grass higher than eight (8) inches is hereby declared detrimental to the public health, safety, and general welfare of the property owners and residents of the Town of Greenwood and a common and public nuisance.”

Yard Waste – Yard Waste may be taken to either Delaware Solid Waste Authority location: Ellendale (302-422-8632) or Bridgeville (302-337-3521). Please call them for specifics. Remember yard waste is not allowed in the Town trash bins. Burning Ban will be in affect from May 1st through October 1st.
