### POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

- School is back in session! The Woodbridge School District is back in session September 16, 2020. School hours have changed so please be aware of students walking to bus stops and to school throughout the day.
- Learn and obey the school bus laws as well as the “flashing signal light system” that school bus drivers use to alert motorists of pending actions: Yellow flashing lights indicate the bus is preparing to stop to load or unload children. Motorists should slow down and prepare to stop their vehicles. Red flashing lights and extended stop arms indicate the bus has stopped and children are getting on or off of the school bus. Motorists must stop their cars and wait until the red lights stop flashing, the extended stop arm is withdrawn and the bus begins moving before starting to drive.
