MAYORS MESSAGE: *Spring has sprung in Greenwood! We have scheduled a bulk trash pick-up as you begin your Spring cleaning projects. We are also excited to begin working on some future projects for the Town and would like your feedback. We are gathering information on the Hometown Heroes project, as well as, the possibility of a Farmers Market once a month in the Town Hall parking lot during the Summer months. Reminders: As the Spring season is upon us just a few reminders:

- * Ordinance A-3-B references lawn maintenance and the disposal of grass clippings. The grass clippings cannot be blown into the street and no grass should be over 8" in height. All trees and shrubbery should be trimmed as so not to inhibit visibility or extend over any street or walkway. **Also please remember yard waste cannot be disposed of in the trash bins provided by the Town.**
- * Please remember as the weather gets warmer many residents walk around the Town. There is no parking on public sidewalks per Delaware Code Title 21. This is a safety issue.
- * Any untagged or any vehicle that is not currently registered is not permitted on any property in the Town of Greenwood per Ordinance D-8.
- * Burning: Please see the attached page concerning open burning in the Town.

Any violations of the above Ordinances will be handled by Code Enforcement. We appreciate your cooperation!

TOWN OF GREENWOOD OPEN BURNING

Allowable Open Burning Activities Include:

- Cooking fires (limited to 10 cubic feet at one time).
- Campfires, patio fire pits, or chimenea (limited to 27 cubic feet at one time).
- Ceremonial bonfires conducted by established groups such as schools, churches, or other recognized organizations (limited to 27 cubic feet at one time).
- Burning small amounts of cut or fallen branches, limbs, or shrubbery from your residence (limited to 27 cubic feet at one time). This burning is banned during the Ozone Season. May 1-Sept. 30. From Oct. 1-April 30, such burning is only allowed between 8 a.m.-4 p.m.

Notifying the County Fire Board

Before conducting an open burning activity (except cooking fires, campfires, patio fire pits, chimenea, and ceremonial bonfires) a homeowner must notify their local county fire board.

- Kent County: 302-734-6040
- Sussex County: 302-856-6306

Materials Which Are Always Prohibited From Being Burned Include:

- Leaves
- Grass Clippings
- Garbage/Trash
- Burning more than 27 cubic feet of branches, limbs, or shrubbery at one time at a residence.
- Burning cut or fallen branches, limbs, or shrubbery not generated by the homeowner's residence.
- Land-clearing material that has not been generated for the purpose of establishing agricultural operations.

ALL open burning is prohibited when the Delaware State Fire Marshal has issued a burning ban.

ALSO PLEASE REMEMBER YOU WILL NEED TO APPLY FOR A BURN PERMIT AT TOWN HALL BEFORE BURNING.

Inadvertent collection of material placed in, on, or adjacent to bulk items to be collected, will not be the responsibility of the Town nor the waste service company.

Material is to be placed at the curb prior to the morning pick up start.

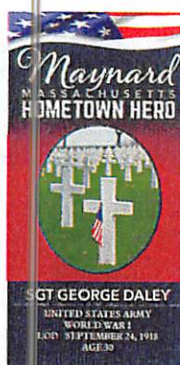

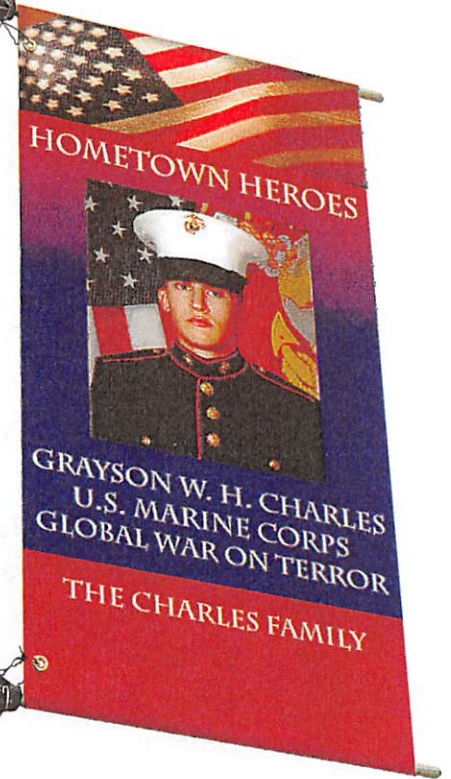
