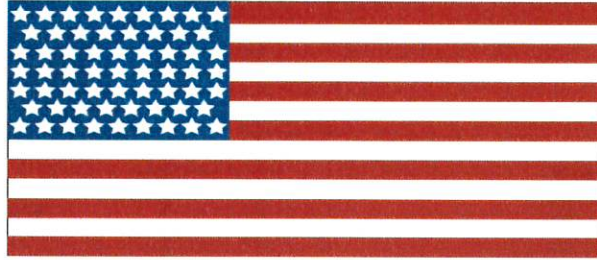

SUMMER SWIMMING SAFETY TIPS

While drowning deaths peak among 1 and 2 yr. olds, drowning continues to be the 2nd leading cause of preventable deaths through age 15. So remember:

- DON'T GO IN THE WATER UNLESS YOU KNOW HOW TO SWIM. SWIMMING LESSONS ARE AVAILABLE FOR ALL AGES. ALWAYS SWIM IN WATERS SUITABLE TO YOUR SKILL LEVEL.
- NEVER SWIM ALONE.
- LEARN CPR AND RESCUE TECHNIQUES.
- SWIM IN AREAS SUPERVISED BY A LIFEGUARD OR AN ADULT.
- DON'T PUSH OR JUMP ON OTHERS.
- DON'T DIVE IN UNFAMILIAR AREAS.



BICYCLE SAFETY:

- Wear equipment to protect you and make you more visible to others (bike helmet, bright clothing, reflective gear and a white front light & red rear light and reflectors on your bike).
- Ride one per seat, with both hands on the handlebars, unless signaling a turn.
- Carry all items in a backpack or strapped to the back of the bike.
- Tuck and tie your shoelaces and pant legs so they don't get caught in your bike chain.
- Drive with the flow, in the same direction as traffic.
- Obey street signs, signals and road markings.
- Assume the other person doesn't see you; look ahead for hazards or situations to avoid that may cause you to fall (ex. pebbles, potholes, grates, train tracks).
- Do not text or listen to music or use anything that distracts you from taking your eyes and ears or your mind off of the road and traffic.
