SPECIAL MEETING
TUESDAY NOV. 16, 2021 6:30 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Donovan called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

PRESENT:

Mayor Donald Donovan, Vice Mayor Willard Russell, Council members Don Torbert, Mike Moran and Norman Reed, Town Manager Janet Todd, Town Clerk Carolyn Chisenhall, Chief Brent Raughley and Accreditation Mgr. Shelley Lambden.

Mayor Donovan opened the meeting by asking if there were any questions about the presented budget. Chief Raughley explained the part time officer they have hired is having surgery and will not be ready to work until early Spring. Councilman Reed asked if that would be March or April and Chief replied yes. Ms. Lambden explained his payroll was budget at 29.5 hours per week for 12 months. Mayor Donovan asked if that would make the payroll budget less because he will not be working until Spring to which the Chief and Ms. Lambden replied that is correct. Councilman Torbert asked the Chief for the status of Sgt. Cullens injury. Chief stated Sgt. has a follow-up visit in December and will not have an update until then. Councilman Reed asked about the return of Officer Carignan to which the Chief stated he is supposed to be back in the States in December but that is always subject to change.

Mayor Donovan stated he would like to adopt the budget presented with the hiring a PT officer. Councilman Mike Moran stated he would like to adopt the budget with a PT officer and Councilman Torbert agreed. Councilman Reed mad a motion to adopt the budget with the hiring of the PT officer and Councilman Moran made a second. The motion was passed by unanimous vote Vice Mayor Russell-Yes Councilman Reed-Yes, Councilman Torbert-Yes Councilman Moran-Yes. Chief Raughley asked the Council to verify this is the budget with hiring a PT officer and no C.O.L raise and Mayor Donovan verified that is correct.
