WINTER DRIVING TIPS

Winter Driving:

-Remove any snow on your vehicle's windows, lights, and roof.

-Leave plenty of space between you and the surrounding vehicles in case there is black ice.

-Stay attentive and reduce speed. Ice and snow, take it slow!

-Give snowplows room to work.

Driving Restrictions Explained:

Level One: Drivers are discouraged from operating a motor vehicle on the state's roadways, unless there is a significant safety, health or business reason to do so.

Level Two: Travel on the roads is restricted to emergency workers, public utilities, healthcare providers including hospital staff, private sector food and fuel deliveries, and those industries, companies or organization that have been provided a waiver, including businesses with pressing continuity and operational issues.

Level Three: Complete ban on driving except for first responders and utility personnel.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS CONCERNING TOWN PROPERTY TAXES:

Q. WHEN ARE GREENWOOD PROPERTY TAXES BILLED?
A. THE FIRST WEEK OF JANUARY EACH YEAR

Q. WHEN ARE THE TOWN TAXES DUE?
A. FEBRUARY 28TH

Q. IF MY MORTGAGE COMPANY PAYS MY TAXES, DOES THE TOWN SEND THEM THE BILL?
A. NO, THE TOWN SENDS THE BILL TO THE PROPERTY OWNER AND IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROPERTY OWNER TO SEND IT TO THEIR MORTGAGE COMPANY.

Q. HOW CAN I PAY MY BILL?
A. ON THE TOWN WEBSITE WWW.GREENWOOD.DELAWARE.GOV, MAIL A CHECK, PUT A CHECK IN THE DROPBOX AT TOWN HALL OR PAY IN PERSON.

Duck Creek Lane Parking:

As a reminder, there is no street parking allowed on Duck Creek Lane, in either direction. This will be strictly enforced starting in January.

LICENSING:

- PLEASE REMEMBER ALL BUSINESSES ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A BUSINESS LICENSE EACH YEAR WITH THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD TO CONDUCT BUSINESS IN TOWN. THE APPLICATION IS AVAILABLE ON THE TOWN WEBSITE AND AT TOWN HALL. PLEASE COMPLETE THE APPLICATION AND ATTACH A COPY OF THE DELAWARE BUSINESS LICENSE, PROOF OF INSURANCE AND PAYMENT.
- RENTAL LICENSE: ALL PROPERTIES THAT ARE LEASED ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A RENTAL LICENSE WITH THE TOWN EACH YEAR. FORMS ARE AVAILABLE ONLINE AND AT TOWN HALL.
