REMINDERS:

BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR

Please keep your grass cut and refrain from blowing clippings out into the street or sidewalk. Also, trees & shrubs must be kept trimmed so as not to inhibit visibility or free passage of vehicles or pedestrians. (Ord. A-39)

Garbage & recycling bins should be set out at the appropriate place for pickup after 4:30 pm on the day before pickup. The empty cans should be removed by 6:00 pm the day of collection. (Ord. C-5-C)

To facilitate the identification of buildings for emergencies and other purposes, any building that has a street number must place such number upon the building so as it is clearly visible from the street. Numbers must be between 4" and 8" high, with a minimum width of 3". (Ord. A-17)
