

make no changes, (2) make a Comp. Plan amendment with minor changes, or (3) decide it is no longer relevant and redo the whole Comprehensive Plan. The review will need to be completed by May 29, 2024.

- Ordinance 2024-01, Ordinance Repealing Prior Ordinances Governing the Sewer System within the Town of Greenwood was presented for first reading. Since the County has taken over the sewer, these Ordinances are no longer relevant.
- Mayor Kemp encouraged the Council to review the Charter and bring back potential changes to the Council meeting in April.
- Discussion was had about possible Community Events.
- The use of the Ballfield and the license agreement was discussed again, with participation by Tim Uber of Diamond State Ducks and Chris Haymond of Woodbridge Little League. Mr. Haymond stated that “we need to find a path forward”, and told Mr. Uber, “I understand you have trust issues, but let’s work it out”. Vice-Mayor Moran suggested the Woodbridge Little League have use of the softball field from Monday through Friday, now until June 30, with the Ducks being able to practice there on the weekends. WLL will have use of the tee ball field all the time. The Ducks would have use of the softball field July 1 through October, but if WLL needs it for fall ball they can contact Mr. Moran so it can be worked out. Mr. Haymond will discuss it with WLL’s board and let the Council know if that’s acceptable to them.
- Discussion was held about the Town Hall office and Ring cameras.
- Mayor Kemp asked that we as representatives of the Town refrain from speaking negatively about anyone in the public portion of meetings.
- Councilwoman Jones read from the Charter regarding duties of Mayor and Council. She also added that she wants to recommend something prohibiting council members from being related by blood or marriage to the Charter discussion for next month.

Vice-Mayor Moran read a letter that was sent to him by resident Stacey Parnell. Charlotte Torbert read a statement she had written to Councilwoman Tallent. Anthony Massey is working on getting student volunteers from Woodbridge.
