Ordinance A-2, Section 2: Building Permits: Prior to engaging in construction activities, any building contractor, property owner, or other responsible party shall obtain a building permit authorizing the construction activities, along with any required federal, state, county, and/or local agency permits. In addition to new construction, building permits are required for accessory structures (such as sheds, gazebos, and carports), and additions and renovations (including decks, porches, patios, siding, and fences). Roofing that includes structural sheathing or a change in material (like shingle to metal), requires a permit, but just putting shingles over shingles does not. Many things that require a Town permit also require a Sussex County permit. See Sussex County's "Permitting Requirements within Municipalities" on their website, sussexcountyde.gov, or call their permitting office at 302-855-7720.

Building permits are NOT required for interior painting, papering, tiling, carpeting, cabinets, counter tops, replacement of interior or exterior doors, electrical, or plumbing. However, anyone doing business in the Town of Greenwood is required to have a Town of Greenwood business license, so please ensure that your contractor gets one.

If you are not certain if you need a building permit for your project or if your contractor is licensed in Greenwood, please call Town Hall at 302-349-4534 and we will be happy to assist you.
